Last Class: 70 Weeks Prophecy

Prophecy brought them from Nehemiah's day unto Christ

- Daniel was given the time period from the building of the wall unto the Messiah
- Told what was going to be accomplished at the end of this time period:
 - To finish the transgression
 - Fill up or perfect the Transgressions of the people
 - To make an end of sins
 - End of the Sin offering (Law of Moses was fulfilled)
 - To make reconciliation for iniquity
 - The covering of iniquity or sin (Heb 10:4)
 - To bring in everlasting righteousness
 - The way in which the faithful could be "righteous"
 - Seal up the vision AND THE prophet (the prophet the vision is about)
 - To seal the prophet Jesus Christ "sealed of his father"
 - Anoint the most Holy

- Anoint the "holy one" of the "holy ones" the Messiah with the Holy Spirit (at his Baptism)
- Then at the end of the time period the messiah would be "cut off" or put to death and finally the city would be destroyed

Looking for the Messiah

Those looking for Messiah

Luke 2:25

And, behold, there was a man in Jerusalem, whose name was Simeon; and the same man was just and devout, *waiting for the consolation of Israel*: and the Holy Spirit was upon him.

There were many other prophecies that shed light on the coming Messiah – remember what Jesus said to his disciples before he was taken into heaven:

<u>Luke 24:25-27</u> Then he said unto them, O fools, and slow of heart to believe all that the prophets have spoken: Ought not Christ to have suffered these things, and to enter into his glory? And <u>beginning at Moses and all the prophets, he</u> <u>expounded unto them in all the scriptures the things concerning himself</u>.

Beginning at Moses:

The First Prophecy of the Messiah:

The Seed of the Woman:

<u>Genesis 3:15</u>

And I will put enmity between thee and the woman, and between thy seed and <u>her seed</u>; <u>it shall bruise thy head</u>, and thou <u>shalt bruise his heel</u>.

- The woman would have a seed
 - Miraculous statement (physical impossibility)
 - It would crush the head (thinking of the serpent)
 - This would be permanent
- The serpent would bruise the heel of the woman's seed
 - This would be temporary (repairable)

The Law Giver from Judah:

	<u>Genesis 49:9-10</u>	Judah is a lion's whelp: from the prey, my son, thou art gone up: he stooped
		down, he couched as a lion, and as an old lion; who shall rouse him up? The
		<u>sceptre shall not depart from Judah</u> , nor a <u>lawgiver</u> from between his feet,
		until <u>Shiloh</u> come; and unto him shall the gathering of the people be.
•	Sceptre: 7	7626 – shebet – tribe, branch, staff, scepter, rod (shepherd)

- Symbol of shepherding or rulership
- Shiloah 7886 Shiyloh tranquility or rest (Gesenius) the peacemaker

• The Scepter would stay with Judah until REST comes:

- The Rest will not come until he has "put down all rule and authority and power"
 - **<u>1 Cor 15:24-26</u>** Then cometh the end, <u>when he shall have delivered up the</u> <u>kingdom to God, even the Father; when he shall have put down</u> <u>all rule and all authority and power</u>. For he must reign, till he hath put all enemies under his feet. The last enemy that shall be destroyed is death.

The Star out of Jacob, Scepter from Israel:

<u>Num 24:17-19</u>

I shall see him, but not now: I shall behold him, but not nigh: there shall come a <u>Star out of Jacob</u>, and a <u>Sceptre shall rise out of Israel</u>, and shall smite the corners of Moab, and destroy all the children of Sheth. And Edom shall be a possession, Seir also shall be a <u>possession for his enemies</u>; and <u>Israel shall do</u> <u>valiantly</u>. Out of Jacob shall come he that shall <u>have dominion</u>, and shall destroy him that remaineth of the city.

- c/p Matt 2:2 The king of the Jews we have seen his star
- c/p Rev 22:16 I am the bright and morning star

• God would raise up Prophet like Moses:

- Deut18:15The LORD thy God will raise up unto thee a Prophet from the midst of thee, of
thy brethren, like unto me; unto him ye shall hearken;Deut 18:18I will raise them up a Prophet from among their brethren, like unto thee, and
will put my words in his mouth; and he shall speak unto them all that I shall
command him.
 - Prophet like Moses:
 - God would raise him up
 - He would be from among their brethren
 - Like Moses
 - God would put his words in his mouth
 - Speak what God said
 - His brethren would listen

And the Prophets

His Lineage:

2 Sam 7:12-16 And when thy days be fulfilled, and thou shalt sleep with thy fathers, <u>I will set</u> <u>up thy seed after thee</u>, which shall proceed out of thy bowels, and I will establish his kingdom. He shall build an house for my name, and I will stablish the throne of his kingdom for ever. <u>I will be his father</u>, and <u>he shall be my son</u>. If he commit iniquity, I will chasten him with the rod of men, and with the stripes of the children of men: But my mercy shall not depart away from him, as I took it from Saul, whom I put away before thee. And thine house and thy kingdom shall be established for ever before thee: thy throne shall be established for ever.


- This future heir was to be:
 - Son of David (thy seed)
 - Son of God (I will be his father)

Dual Lineage:

<u> Micah 5:2</u>

But thou, Bethlehem Ephratah, though thou be little among the thousands of Judah, yet <u>out of thee shall he come</u> forth unto me that is to be <u>ruler in Israel</u>; whose <u>goings forth</u> have been <u>from of old</u>, <u>from everlasting</u>.

- Four things we gather from this
 - Future King was to come from Bethlehem
 - He was to be from "of old" son of David
 - "From Everlasting" son of God

The Wonderful Counsellor:

<u>Isaiah 9:6-7</u>

For unto us <u>a child is born</u>, unto us <u>a son is given</u>: and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace. Of the increase of his government and peace there shall be no end, upon the throne of David, and upon his kingdom, to order it, and to establish it with judgment and with justice from henceforth even for ever. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will perform this.

- Double emphasis? Seems to be saying the same thing:
 - \circ The meanings:
 - Child 3206 yeled boy, youth, offspring, fruit
 - Born 3205 yeled to cause to bring forth childbirth (midwife)
 - Son 1221 ben child from 1229 bene- to build a house, establish a family
 - Given 5414 Nathan a gift given, bestowed, provided
- Duel Lineage:
 - $\circ \quad \text{Child is born} \text{son of David}$
 - Son is given son of God

The Branch that Grows out of Jesse:

<u>Isaiah 11:1</u>

And there shall come forth a rod out of the stem of Jesse, and a Branch shall grow out of his roots:

- Rod 2415 Choter branch sucker, twig
- Stem 1508 Gezer trunk of a felled tree, the stock, a newly planted tree
- Branch 5342 Nester a sprout or a shoot
- Roots 8328 sheresh root, bottom, the lowest part

Isaiah 11:2 And the spirit of the LORD shall rest upon him, the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD;

- Rest 5117 nuwach to settle upon, (Gen 8:4 the ark rested)
- Wisdom -5421- chokmah wisdom or skill (Dan 1:17)
- Understanding 998 biynah discernment get the meaning
- Counsel 6098 etsah advise, purpose
- Might 1369 gheborah (from Gibbor) strength, bravery, valour
- Knowledge- 1847 da'ath perception, skill, discernment, from yadah – to know by experience
- Fear 3374 Yirah respect terror, fear
- **Isaiah 11: 3-5** And shall make him of quick understanding in the fear of the LORD: and he shall not judge after the sight of his eyes, neither reprove after the hearing of his ears: But with righteousness shall he judge the poor, and reprove with equity for the meek of the earth: and he shall smite the earth with the rod of his mouth, and with the breath of his lips shall he slay the wicked. And righteousness shall be the girdle of his loins, and faithfulness the girdle of his reins.
 - Quick understanding 7306 ruwach to smell, catch the scent, to perceive by observation
 - Fear 3374 Yirah respect, terror, fear
 - Seeing of the eyes & hearing of the ears
 - This was how EVE judged what the serpent said
 - Righteousness 6664- Szedek -
 - Equity 4334 miyshowr uprightness

A Virgin shall Conceive

Isaiah 7:14-15

Therefore the Lord himself shall give you a sign; Behold, a virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, and shall call his name Immanuel. Butter and honey shall he eat, that he may know to refuse the evil, and choose the good.

- Sign 226 owth miracle, or sign
- Virgin 5959 almah a girl of marriageable age
- Immanuel 6005 God with us
- Butter & Honey tokens of the "good" of the land -
 - c/p Heb 12:2 "for the joy set before him"

When would this happen?

Isaiah 7:16

For **before** the child shall know to refuse the evil, and choose the good, **the** land that thou abhorrest shall be forsaken of both her kings.

After the Assyrio – Babylonish captivity

The Key of the House of David:

<u>Isaiah 22:20-25</u> And it shall come to pass in that day, that I will call my servant Eliakim the son of Hilkiah: And I will clothe him with thy robe, and strengthen him with thy girdle, and I will commit thy government into his hand: and he shall be a father to the inhabitants of Jerusalem, and to the house of Judah. And the key of the house of David will I lay upon his shoulder; so he shall open, and none shall shut; and he shall shut, and none shall open. And I will fasten him as a nail in a sure place; and he shall be for a glorious throne to his father's house. And they shall hang upon him all the glory of his father's house, the offspring and the issue, all vessels of small quantity, from the vessels of cups, even to all the vessels of flagons. In that day, saith the LORD of hosts, shall the nail that is fastened in the sure place be removed, and be cut down, and fall; and the burden that was upon it shall be cut off: for the LORD hath spoken it.

- Eliakim 471- who God raises or sets up
- Hilkiah 2518 "my portion is Yahweh" •
- Therefore: The one who God raises up, whose portion is Yahweh
- This one will have the Government:
 - **Commit 5414 Nathan** entrust, give as a gift
 - . Government - 4476 - memshalah - dominion
- He will be a "father" to the inhabitants of Jerusalem & the house of "Judah"
 - He will be the "spiritual father"
- The Key of the house of David laid on his shoulder
 - Key 4668 maphteach key or an opening
 - Lay 5414 Nathan bestow, grant, entrust
 - Shoulder 7926 shekem shoulder

• "so he shall open, and none shall shut; and he shall shut, and none shall open"

<u>Revelation 3:7</u> And to the angel of the ecclesia in Philadelphia write; These things saith he that is holy, he that is true, he that hath <u>the key of David</u>, he that openeth, and no man shutteth; and shutteth, and no man openeth;

<u>Matthew 16:19</u> And I will give unto thee the <u>keys of the kingdom of heaven</u>: and whatsoever thou shalt bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.

He Wakeneth my Ear:

<u>Isaiah 50:4-6</u>

The Lord GOD hath given me <u>the tongue of the learned</u>, that I should know how to speak a <u>word in season</u> to him that is weary: he wakeneth morning by morning, he wakeneth mine ear to <u>hear as the learned</u>. The Lord GOD hath opened mine ear, and I was not rebellious, neither turned away back. I gave my back to the smiters, and my cheeks to them that plucked off the hair: I hid not my face from shame and spitting.

- Learned: 3928 limmuwd disciple, a learner, one taught the tongue of the expert
- Know: 3045 yadah know by experience
- Speak: 5790 uwth to hasten,m to succor, to assist, to help wearied people
- In season & weary: 3287 (2x) ya'epth to the weary, faint
- Waketh 5782 uwr to rouse, stir up, c/p Ezra 1:5 Levites with all those whose spirit God had raised up to build the house, Isa 52:1 – awake put on thy strength O Zion
- Ear 241 ozen ear
- Hear 8085 shama hear, perceive, understand, to heed, obey, give heed
- Learned: 3928 likmmuwd disciple, learner, one taught,
- Opened: 6605 pathach to grave, to open as gates, to engrave, carve, c/p Exod 28:9 – grave on the onyx stones the names of the children of Israel; 2 Chron 3:7 – cherubim graved on the walls
- Rebelious: 4784 Marah to be disobedient to a father, rebellious, to lash with a whip, c/p Deut 21:18-21 "if a man have a stubborn and rebellious son, which will not obey the voice of his father..."

<u>Revelation 1:18</u> I am he that liveth, and was dead; and, behold, I am alive for evermore, Amen; and **have the keys of hell and of death**.

The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon me:

- **Isaiah 61:1-3** The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon me; because the LORD hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; he hath sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them that are bound; To proclaim the acceptable year of the LORD, and the day of vengeance of our God; to comfort all that mourn; To appoint unto them that mourn in Zion, to give unto them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they might be called trees of righteousness, the planting of the LORD, that he might be glorified.
 - Spirit: 7307 ruwach wind, breath, mind, spirit
 - Anointed: 4886 mashach smear, anoint, spread a liquid, consecrate
 - Preach Good Tidings: 1319 basar publish, bear tidings, announce good news
 - Meek: 6035 'anav meek, humble, afflicted, poor
 - Sent: 7971 shalach send c/p Isa 6:8 "who shall I send, who will go for us.... Here am I send me"
 - Bind: 2280 Chabash bind, bind on, bind up, bandage, as a turban around a head, as a wound is bound, a healer c/p Job 5:18 he bindeth up my wound... his hands make whole; Ezek 34:4 strengthening the diseased, Isa 30:26 Yahweh bindeth up the breach of his people
 - Broken 7665 shabar to be broken, maimed, crippled, wrecked, crushed
 - Hearted 3820 leb the inner man, mind, will, heart, understanding
 - Proclaim: 7121 qara to cry, utter a loud sound, read aloud, summon, invite, call and commission, appoint, call and endow, call, name give name to
 - Liberty: 1865 d^erowr a flowing, run free, liberty, swift flight like a bird, c/p Ex 30:23 flowing myrrh
 - Captives: 7617: shabah to lead captive, taken in war
 - Opening of the prision: 6495: p^eqach-qowach opening of eyes wide, restore sight to bhe blind, enable to see things which were otherwise hid from mortal eyes c/p Gen 21:19; Psa 146:8 – The LORD openeth the eyes of the blind: the LORD raiseth them that are bowed down....
 - Bound: 631 'acar prisoner, bound with a harness, cords,
 - Proclaim: 7121 as above
 - Acceptable: 7522 ratsown pleasure, delight, goodwill, pleasing to God c /p Isa 56:7 – accepted upon my altar; Prov 15:8 – prayer of the upright is his delight
 - Year: 8141 shaneh division of time, year
 - Day: 3117 yowm day from root "to be hot" (ie. heat of the day)
 - Vengeance: 5359 naqam revenge, c/p Psa 149:7 to execute vengeance upon the people, Micah 5:14, Psalm 18:48 – It is God that avengeth me
 - Comfort: 5162 Nacham to comfort or to console
 - Mourn: 57 abel to be wet with moisture of grass, to be wet with tears from mourning
 - Appoint: 7760 suwm set, ordain, extend, establish, put in place

- Mourn: 57 as above
- Give: 5414 Nathan gift, bestow, consecrate,
- Beauty 6287 P^e'er head dress, ornament, turban, tiara, of the High priest c/p Exodus 39:28 – goodly bonnets of fine linen...
- Ashes 665 'epher dust of the earth, mourning, Jer 6:26 "Wallow thyself in ashes: make thee mourning..."
- Oil 8081 shemem olive oil, fatness Isa 25:6 "a feast of fat things"
- Joy 8342 sasown gladness, exultation, rejoicing Isa 35:10 ransomed of the LORD... everlasting joy upon their heads..."
- Mourning 60 'ebel mourning for the dead
- Garment 4594 ma'ateh wrap or mantle, vail
- Praise 8416 t^ehillah song of praise, hymn of praise, Psa 51:17 my lips shall show forth praise; Psa 145:1 – I will extol thee... praise thy name forever; Psa 22:4 – thou inhabitest the praise of Israel
- 7307- Ruach (as above)
- Heaviness 3544 keheh dim, dull, dark, faint, failing weak, specially of a wick burning with a very little flame, almost gone out c/p lsa 42:3 a smoking flax; 1 Sam 3:2 Eli's eyes waxed dim
- Might be called 7121 qara proclaimed, called, chosen
- Trees 352 'ayil ram, pillar, door post, strong man, mighty tree (terebinth)
- Righteousness 6664 Tsedeq rightouesness, straightness, just, upright – Psa 15:2, walking uprightly, Isa 45:19 – I the LORD speak righteousness (truth)
- Planting 4302 Matta plantation Isa 60:21 thy people shall be all righteous, they shall inherit the land for ever, the branch of my planting, the work of my hands, that I may be glorified
- Glorified: 6286 pa'ar to be adorned, honoured... c/p Mal 3:17 they shall be mine when I make up my jewels (treasure)
