The Greatness of Deuteronomy

- It identifies the One True God and emphasizes His holiness
- It is ruthless against images, idolatry and worship of other gods.
- It affirms the everlasting love of God to Israel
- It is based on God's absolute faithfulness to His covenants with the fathers of Israel.
- It expects that the response will be to show love and obedience
- It teaches that God has chosen one holy people
- It shows that imitating God's kindness will lead to willing generosity to those less fortunate than ourselves
- It enshrines honesty, fairness and thoughtfulness .
- It is concerned for the One faith to be faithfully passed on to future generations
- It clearly outlines God's unchanging morality, and the rigid consequences for defiance .
