v1-2 Link with Rom 5. What must our response be? God's grace teaches us to live a Godly life.

v3-8 Baptism is a burial. It is a symbolic death and resurrection.

v4 We publicly declare that we want to be like Jesus.

v5 We must live as if resurrected to immortality. If we are "in Christ", we have a guarantee of resurrection.

v6-8 We "die" with Christ, but also "live" the life of Christ

Repentance fundamental to salvation:

We come to repentance by allowing the Word of God into our minds to change us. Appreciating God's goodness leads us to repentance: Rom 2:4. Repentance, baptism and forgiveness frees us from our past, and opens up the future.

Matt 11:28 Those who are heavy laden will be given rest. God wants to help us by restoring our relationship with Him.

Baptism is one of four New Testament symbols believers follow. The others are: bread and wine (1 Cor 15:20-29). Also headcoverings in ecclesial meetings (1 Cor 15:1-16). All these symbols represent forgiveness and salvation in Christ, by grace through faith. Those baptised take bread and wine in memorial meetings (1 Cor 10:15-17; Acts 2:38-42)
