# v5-7 God's character:

Moses' experience is similar to that of Elijah in 1 Kings 19:11-**13**. Jesus Christ is the perfect example of God's character. the word made flesh: John 1v14.

Merciful: compassionate, Heb 5:2 Matt 9:36 Gracious: Undeserved favor Longsuffering: 1 Pet 3:20 Goodness: kindness/mercy, translated as "mercy" in 34:7. Truth: Psa 85:10

God's character is one of both Goodness and Severity: Rom 11:22.
