Bodies remained in a state of non decay. Could not therefore be called a death of 105 days


Decorum of the symbol requires another solution!

Days = Lunar days (ie. time it takes for the moon to revolve once around the earth. = 30 of our days.)

Summary. 1 Lunar day = 30 of our days.

3 ½ Lunar days x 30 = 105days = 105yrs.







### **Revelation 11**

Anti Papal witnesses







Estates-General convened on May 5, 1789, by Louis XVI, at Versailles, in a desperate attempt to stave off civil unrest.

Established in 1302, the Estates-General was a French legislative body comprising members of three groups, or estates, of society: clergy, nobility, and commoners.

However, the Commoners (3<sup>rd</sup> Estate) voted June 17<sup>th</sup> to make themselves a permanent National Assembly.(With or without the other two) Louis's efforts to repress the new assembly caused widespread

rioting and ushered in the French Revolution.


As a culmination of their campaign of moral regeneration, the National Convention (first met Sept.1792) authorised the creation of a civic religion. The cult of the Supreme Being" (May 1794)

Robespierre introduced the legislation with a speech entitled, <u>On the principles of political morality</u> "Immorality," he declared, "is the basis of despotism, as virtue is the essence of the republic."





## French Revolution at a glance

### 1789

- •May 5<sup>th</sup> opening session of Estates General.
- •June 17<sup>th</sup> Third estate declares itself the National Assembly.
- •July 14<sup>th</sup> Fall of the Bastille.
- •November 2<sup>nd</sup> Property of Church placed at disposal of the nation.

1790

•June 19th Titles of hereditary nobility abolished.

1791

October 1<sup>st</sup> Legislative Assembly opens.

- •August 10<sup>th</sup> Insurrection overthrows Louis XVI.
- •September 20<sup>th</sup> first meeting of National Convention.
